

SAFETY POLICY STOP WORK AUTHORITY

Since 2013, Termisol Termica s.r.l. has introduced a specific safety policy called Stop Work Authority, which gives each worker the power to stop work activities when, in their opinion, they are carried out in an unsafe manner (in the context of workplace safety or environmental protection). The fundamental purpose of this policy is to prevent the occurrence of any type of accident (accidents, occupational diseases, damage to material assets or environmental damage).

In the event that the worker stops a work activity for safety reasons, he must promptly notify his direct superior (team leader, assistant, site manager) or the site safety officer.

In general terms, the Stop Work Authority policy is identified as a process divided into four consecutive phases:

- 1) Stop (suspension of work activities by the worker);
- 2) Notification (timely information to his direct superior);
- 3) Correction (where possible, safety conditions must be re-established before resuming activities);
- 4) Resumption of work activities subject to verification and restoration of appropriate safety conditions.
